Students have to select five subjects:

Students are required to select five subjects in bachelor degree course as per the National Education Policy 2020. The student will have to select one subject as **MAJOR** subject and another as **MINOR** subject from its own faculty, third subject he can select from any other faculty as **ELECTIVES**, fourth one will be **VOCATIONAL** subject and fifth one will be **FOUNDATION** subject. Each year, there will be mandatory internship/field project/apprenticeship/community engagement and service. For that, 4 credits have been fixed each year. In the fourth year, credits for internship/field project will be 12.

Bachelor's degree with research

If the student is eligible and wishes to continue in the fourth year of UG course, he/she will be taught research methodology and manner to prepare thesis. Apart from this they will also get additional chance of internship/apprenticeship which will increase their employability.

Students will have compulsory study following subjects at UG level

- One Main Subject (Major) – 54 credits
- One Minor Subject (Minor) – 28 credits
- One Elective Subject – 18 credits
- One Skill Subject – 12 credits
- One Foundation subject -- 24
- Internship / Project / Apprenticeship -- 24

Subjects to study in UG fourth year

- Three main papers
- Research Methodology/Undergraduate Thesis
- Internship / Project / Apprenticeship

Availability of Elective

Availability of option will be ensured in each college for the selection of inter-discipline subject.

Teaching arrangements for the subjects of other disciplines in a single discipline college can be done with the help of teachers posted in the colleges located in the district headquarters.

In single discipline colleges of arts and commerce, the option to choose a subject from the science faculty will not be available.

A total of 25 electives will be available in arts faculty followed by 20 in science and five in course. Three more electives viz NCC, NSS and physical education will be available for students to choose.

Vocational Subject

Vocational subjects will be of 4 credits per year, and the duration of training will be 60 hours.

Students can study new vocational courses every year or on continue with the same subject the basis of progressive skill enhancement in the selected course can study on.

DHE has listed 25 vocational subjects which include nutrition and dietetics, personality development, export import management, e-accounting and taxation with GST, finance services and insurance, retail management digital marketing, organic farming, vermicomposting, dairy management etc.

SEMESTER EXAMINATION SYSTEM INTRODUCTION

Semester system was introduced for all Post Graduation and Bachelor of Education (B.ED.) courses in all colleges of Madhya Pradesh from 2008-09 academic sessions. A decision in this regard has been taken by the state government's Higher Education department. A year consists of two semesters which are called winter session and summer session. Every six months semester ends with semester examination. To appear in these examination students have to fill the examination form in each semester. In semester examination students have to score minimum marks. If they fail to secure minimum marks in a particular subject they will be awarded ATKT for those subjects. In this case they have to fill examination form for each ATKT subject again in next session. During fifth semester students go through CCE, practical, internship work. It has marks for each task and these marks are included in final examination result.

ANNUAL EXAMINATION SYSTEM INTRODUCTION

Annual Examination system was introduced by Higher Education for graduates courses (BA, BCOM, BSC, BBA) in all colleges of Madhya Pradesh from academic session 2017-18. A decision in this regard has been taken by the state government's Higher Education Department. Yearly Exam consists of two papers in each subject. To appear in these examination student has to fill the examination form. In yearly examination student have to score minimum marks if He/She fails to secure minimum marks in less than two subjects they will be awarded a supplementary for those subjects. In this case they have to fill Supplementary examination form for that subject again. Securing less than minimum marks by a student in more than two subjects His/ Her result will be declared failed and in this case student will have to reappear in that Examination as Ex-Student.

College Admission Process

College admission process is online from past five years. Students can apply through higher education portal. The details of the admission rules, fees and others information of the colleges are also available on the official portal. Students have to follow various steps to take admission in the college. For Assistance you can approach Rai Saheb Bhanwar Singh College to take admission.

1. First of all, you have to register on higher education portal from RSB College. The college will help you in registration.
2. After registration, students have to verify their entire documents from any government college.
3. Make three sets of the entire document (Photocopy), and go to any government college to verify it with all original documents. They will verify your registration letter and other documents with originals and give you two sets of document with their seal and signature and a verification slip.
4. Submit one set of documents with verification slip where you are trying to take admission.
5. Now relax and wait for online admission list no 1, 2, 3, 4.
6. If your name comes in any admission list than you have to reach college mentioned in admission list and deposit your fees to confirm your seat in the college.

PROVISIONAL-ADMISSION-ELIGIBILITY

Students appearing in the supplementary examination are also eligible for online registration to take provisional admission in the College.

Such Admission will be automatically canceled by higher education if students fail in the supplementary examination and if students passed in the supplementary examination his/ her admission will be confirmed as regular admission.



Student's Code of Conduct

Discipline is a habit at RSB

No one in the institute is above discipline, be it student or staff. Within the campus and outside, students are required to maintain a strict code of conduct. Any type of indiscipline or misconduct may result in expulsion of a student.

Ragging Strictly Prohibited

"If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authorities, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authorities will expel him from the institution."

Ragging is totally prohibited either physically or mentally in College. Defaulter will be suspended and after enquiry if found guilty will be expelled from the institution. FIR will be lodged with police. Imprisonment up to two years with or without fine may be awarded by the court.

The institute has appointed Anti Ragging Committee consisting of Senior Professors and Faculty to ensure a ragging free environment in the college campus.

Attendance

It is desirable that students attend all the classes to excel in academics. However, as per Barkatullah University, 75% of attendance in all subjects is the minimum requirement to appear in the Semester/ Annual examination, failing which the student shall have to repeat the semester/ Year.

List of Photostat attested documents/certificates to be attached with the Application Form:

- a. Original copy of School leaving certificate/Transfer Certificate (TC)
- b. Attested Photostat copy of eligibility examination.
- c. Photostat of 10th and 12th Marksheet for admission in Under Graduation / Post Graduation first year.
- d. Three Passport Size photographs.
- e. In case of SC/ST/OBC/ AF & PH category Candidates, a certificate from the competent authority in the name of student.
- f. Domicile certificate/ residential proof or certificate
- g. Character certificate
- h. Gap certificate (If applicable)
- i. Caste and income certificate (for scholarship)
- j. Migration certificate (If applicable)

Note: Students who are seeking admission in the college have to submit university enrollment fees along with enrollment application form within 15 days of admission.



Attendance Rules

1. Students should attend all classes regularly and punctually.
2. Students coming late to the class by more than five minutes will not be given attendance for that period.
3. A student with less than 75% of attendance will not be eligible to appear as regular student in the Examinations of the University.
4. Students are not permitted to be absent without prior permission. An application for leave must be submitted in advance or at least a day before the leave is required.
5. Students without Identity Card & proper Uniform will not be permitted in the campus and will be marked as absent.

NOTE: All students are required to mark their arrival and departure time in the Biometric System Machine without any exception.

Library Rules

The Library is open to all the students and staffs of the College.

Readers are not allowed to enter the library with their college bag.

Readers are prohibited from engaging in any activity which may disturb or distract the attention of other readers and will result in severe disciplinary action.

No reader shall damage, write or make marks on any library book.

Each student of the College will be issued two books at a time.

Date, label and book pockets shall not be tampered, serious action will be taken on any violation of this rule.

Library books are not transferable.

A reader who fails to return a book on the due date will be charged a sum of Rs 5 per day as a fine till he/she returns the book. Such students will not be allowed to use the library till the book is returned and fines are paid.

At the end of each semester or before receiving the examination admit card, the student should return all the books to the library.

The Librarian in college may recall any book at any time even if the normal period of loan has not expired.

Dictionaries and books which might be difficult to replace and such other books declared as Reference Books shall not be available on loan. Such books can be issued for reading in the library itself.

Readers shall be responsible for any damage done to the books or other property belonging to the Library of the College. If the replacement of the books or other properties is not possible, four times the value of the book/property may be collected from the concerned student.



COMPUTER & INTERNET LAB

1. Access to the Internet is a privilege, not a right.
2. Students must produce identity card when demanded, to utilize the lab resources.
3. Footwear's are not allowed inside the computer lab.
4. Students are not allowed to download pictures, music, videos or files without the permission of a faculty.
5. Do not bring Foods or drinks inside the computer lab.
6. Do not install software's without permission.
7. Do not remove or disconnect parts, cables, or labels.
8. Usages of storage devices (CD, DVD, Pen Drive, External HDD, etc.) are prohibited.
9. Irrelevant websites or games are prohibited.
10. Ask to faculty for permission to print any documents.
11. Maintain silence inside the lab.
12. Do not personalize the computer settings. (This includes desktop, screen saver, etc.)
13. Shut down / log off your computer System or leave the computer ready for the next person to use.
14. Pick-up your materials and rearrange the seats.



EXAMINATION RULES

1. Students should reach **examination** Center at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time with his/ her admit card/ Hall Ticket.
2. Student must maintain complete silence in the examination room. If a Student has any kind of query he/she should raise his/her hand and wait for the invigilator.
3. Students will have to sit through the entire period scheduled for the internal tests and university examinations.
4. Mobile Phone and Other Unauthorized Electronic Gadgets are prohibited in the College.
5. University/ college will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any personnel belongings in or outside the examination hall.
6. Please check that you have the correct question paper and read the instructions printed on your examination question paper carefully.
7. All examinations are anonymous. Therefore, do not write your name on the answer book. You should write only your Roll number, Enrollment number correctly and legibly, in the space provided on the cover of each answer book.
8. Participant is not allowed to leave his/her seat during the exam without getting permission from the invigilator.

FEES Related rules

- All fees are subject to annual increases and are not fixed for more than one academic year.
- You may expect fees to increase annually and approximately in line with inflation. Each year at enrolment, we will re-confirm to you the fee you must pay. Where there are significant fee increases these will be communicated to you at the earliest possible.
- You are personally responsible for the payment of your college fees, and take proper receipt for your payment.
- You have to pay fees in account department at reception counter in the college on working days
Timing is as follows
- 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM (For Boys) and 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM (For Girls)
All receipt shall be kept in safe custody for settlement of fees in future. If paying fees in installments, you must pay them by the due date (s).
- You may be required to pay additional fees for university enrollment fees, examination fees, migration fees, eligibility fees or services such as library use, books, equipments, travel and/or accommodation for field trips.
- Students are advised to keep the original receipt of fee deposited for final clearance at the end of the course. It is also mandatory to produce fee receipt at the time of applying for college leaving certificate.

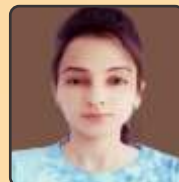

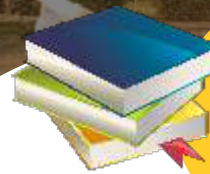
