








Results shows that out of total 1136 students 800 students respond which about to 70.4 respond and not respond about 29.6






Percentage wise Gender Results shows that out of total 800 (70.4%) students respond which about to 64.3 female respond and not respond about 42%




Results shows that out of total 64.3% Female respond the satisfactory survey and 35.8% male respond




Results shows that almost all classes students respond the survey

(F) what degree program are you pursuing now 800 responses




Results shows that all UG & PG classes' students respond the survey and 79.8% UG students respond and rest 20.2% other PG classes' students respond


(G) What subject area are you currently pursuing 800 responses






Results shows the percentagewise graph which shows the 54% students respond 85-100% syllabus covered in the class and 33.1% students respond 70-84% syllabus covered.








Results shows the percentagewise graph which shows the 60.9% students respond excellent to teacher approach and 28.5% students respond very good teacher approach.






Results shows the percentagewise graph which shows the 74.3% students respond every time performance assignment discussed with the students and 20% students respond usually performance assignment discussed with the students






Results shows the percentagewise graph which shows the 60.5% students respond above 90% teacher use ICT tool for teaching .






Results show the percentagewise graph which shows the 75.9% students respond every time to identify the weakness and help to overcome they and 17.6% respond usually.

13. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution. Facilitates you in cognitive social and emotional growth




Results show the percentagewise graph which shows the 58.4%% students respond significantly for facilitation of cognitive, social and emotional growth of the students and 35.7% respond very well.




Results show the percentagewise graph which shows the 73.5% students respond very good library facility and 22.4% respond Good library facility.




Results show the percentagewise graph which shows the 73.5% students respond very good for parking facility in the institution and 27.8% respond Good.




Results show the percentagewise graph which shows the 67.6% students respond very good for Games and sport facility in the institution and 27.4% respond Good.




Results show the percentagewise graph which shows the 69.6% students respond very good for cultural facility in the institution and 26.6% respond Good.




Results show the percentagewise graph which shows the 58.9% students respond very good for canteen facility in the institution and 26.4% respond Good.
